

# Governance Structure Components

## All Members (5,400)



Elect local representatives to the General Assembly (GA), with the number of representatives reflective of board size.

## General Assembly



- Represents all local OPC Districts based on board size
- Meets when required by by-law, ideally three times annually, for PD, networking, information gathering and sharing, discussing local priorities, terms and conditions
- Elects the Governing Board
- Two GA representatives from each district will be designated as Voting Members.
- Serves their local and local interests to reflect membership priorities
- Approves annual budget, votes on provincial terms and conditions agreements.

## Governing Board of Directors



- Hires Executive Director and monitors performance
- Sets OPC policy
- Votes to approve nominations into the General Assembly
- Provides input into draft of annual budget
- Retains strategic oversight
- Oversees risk litigation management
- Are legislated fiduciaries of the Ontario Principals' Council

\* The ED is not a Director but is entitled to attend all Board of Directors meetings.
